Parking

Parking at bwtech@UMBC Research and Technology Park is available at no charge to tenant companies and their visitors. However, parking on the main university campus is restricted. Companies that find themselves frequently interacting with the main campus may want to consider purchasing a UMBC parking permit. bwtech@UMBC tenants can purchase either an annual faculty/staff permit or a daily faculty/staff permit. Both allow parking on non-gated faculty/staff lots and campus roadways. Annual faculty/staff permits expire each year on September 1st. New Permits must be obtained by this date. The fee for FY 2008 is \$260.00. Daily "scratch-off" permits are \$2.00. Permits are available from Parking Services and may be purchased by check or currency (exact amount).
